Who can take part?

If you are a business in Herefordshire, then we would love to hear from you, from sole traders and SMEs through to large corporations.

Who will benefit from the Fund?

We aim to support a wide range of community projects across the county. See overleaf for examples of how HCF has made a positive difference to Herefordshire.

A dedicated decision-making panel will assess the applications for funding and agree the grants to be awarded. For businesses that want to get more involved, there will be opportunities to sit on this panel.

What else do I need to know?

You will receive a branding pack including a window decal for your premises which shows your support for the Fund, plus logos and written info for your website and other marketing collateral.

We'll also send you a quarterly e-newsletter to keep you up to date with what's happening, including details of all grants given, and member events.

To illustrate the impact that your donation could have, here's a few examples of projects that Herefordshire Community Foundation has recently supported via other Funds that it manages.

Helping Herefordshire to Thrive

Growing Local, based just south of Hereford City, works to encourage and educate communities to grow, cook and eat local food. We have funded family cook workshops and children's garden workshops based at their community garden project, with 342 people recently attending.

Artistic engagement at Leominster Priory

Leominster Priory held a high-profile textile exhibition 'Threads Through Creation'. Their grant helped engage local residents of all ages and backgrounds in artistic, nature and creative workshops. They collaborated with Westfield School Sixth Form and ECHO, attracting over 3000 visitors and supported by 139 volunteers.

Breaking down barriers at Ross-on-Wye Rowing Club

Supporting mixed ability rowing sessions at Ross Rowing Club, our grant has enabled those with physical and mental disabilities and those suffering from long-term illnesses to enjoy inclusive rowing sessions. The Club's vision has become an inspiring movement, with 44 participants to date and numbers growing.

Bringing the community together at Kingstone Golden Oldies

The Sunday Lunch Club held in Kingstone Village Hall started during lockdown, enabling isolated people to meet new friends as well as receive a healthy, substantial hot meal. Our funding has supported the continuation of the Club, with up to fifty people attending regularly.
